| Am I eligible for the landscape package? | Only select lots are eligible to receive a front landscaping package. These will be nominated in the contract of sale, along with full terms and conditions. |
| Can we vary or change our landscape packages? | Packages have been specifically designed by landscape architects to thrive in local conditions. Whilst changes are discouraged, plant species are subject to availability and may be swapped. People can add to and personalise their gardens after the landscaping is complete. |
| When will my garden be installed? | Landscaping will begin within 3 months* of receiving your landscape form, and satisfaction of the requirements outlined in your booking request form. *Subject to Terms & Conditions. |
| How tall will the trees grow to? | Tree height will vary depending on the species in your chosen package. Please see individual packages for more information. |
| Will my garden package be exactly like the pictures? | Our pictures are artistic impressions to provide an indication of what to expect. We strive to deliver an aesthetically pleasing outcome for all purchasers. It is important to remember plant species may vary due to plant health and availability. |
| Who is responsible for maintaining my garden? | Your landscape package does include a period of maintenance carried out by our contractor to ensure quality installation. However, once landscaping is complete it is your responsibility to maintain, which should include weeding and a light trim to remove dead flowers from shrubs. An irrigation system will be installed, but this is not automatic and will need to be turned on regularly, particularly in the first year and over summer. As a guide, irrigate for at least two hours at least once a week. The plants selected will be low water use once they are established. |

| Can I have artificial turf laid instead? | No. Synthetic grass and artificial turf is detrimental for the environment and for your garden's biohealth. It also absorbs heat and contributes negatively to the Urban Heat Island effect. |
| What needs to be installed prior to landscaping? | Once your house is complete, you must also install your driveway (including a conduit underneath for irrigation), and a tap. If you want a front fence or paths, these should also be installed by you before landscaping. Please check the detailed requirements in the landscape request form. |
| What is the landscaping package process? | Please see the following page for a detailed explanation of the process. |

Landscaping Process

01

Sign & Settle

Sign your YourLand contract and settle on your land.

02

Check Eligibility

Check your lot is eligible in the Contract of Sale.

03

Construct Home

While your home is being constructed, please ensure everything is completed as outlined in the Design Guidelines.

04

Landscape Request Form

You will be able to email your Landscaping Request Form, along with your name, lot number and Certificate of Occupancy to the landscape contractor.

05

Consultation

The landscape contractor will reach out to you directly to schedule an onsite or online consultation where they will work with you to finalise and document your design. Installation will be scheduled within 4 weeks of receiving your approval of the design.
